Charity work conducted by BMANA-CC

- A BMANA-CC physician donates voluntary hours at the Fayetteville Care Clinic, a Charity Clinic in Fayetteville. The BMANA-CC physicians have been participating in helping the uninsured low income people of Fayetteville with health care need since 2010. Every month they see about 25 to 30 patients without any fees. This compassionate care by this physician group has been going on for months after months and this was duly recognized by the Clinic. BMANA-CC was awarded the Group Volunteer Award in 2011 for its outstanding service.
- Raised over \$17,000 through personal donation during a recent fund-raise for the cyclone victims of Bangladesh and donated over \$21,000 to the cyclone victims.
- Donated over \$5,000 toward the flood victims in Bangladesh during summer 2007.
- Donated \$2,500 for a free health care clinic in Fayetteville, North Carolina.
- Contributed towards the Governor's fund for the victims of Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans and Mississippi during 2005.
- Conducted a community wide Health and Education Fair in 2005 in which Health screenings for Blood pressure, Cholesterol, Glucose, BMI, Stroke, Pulmonary and Dietary Consultation were provided.
- Provided annually financial assistance and educational materials to the Medical Colleges in Bangladesh to support medical resources for the needy students.
- Donation of Endoscopic instruments was made to BMANA-CC from Forsyth Medical Center for donating to a hospital in Bangladesh.
